APPENDIX A

Is your safety plan up to date and have you completed the business self-certification?

The Sonoma County Health Officer **requires** all businesses to create a Social Distancing Protocol & COVID-19 Site-Specific Protection Plan to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and keep businesses open. Complete these steps to open your business:

1. Read required **State Guidance** for your industry.
