# **Statement of Financial Position & Statement of Activity**

Net income for the month of August was \$16,239. Income received was for 2023-2024 Sponsorships. Expenses incurred were primarily for business tools software subscriptions and graphic design. Interest income in the amount of \$1,458 is from the Foundation's money market accounts and certificates of deposit.

# **Accounts Receivable**
